

Instructions to Obtain Acceptable Verification of Tax Information

As part of federal student aid eligibility, the student and parents will be required to consent and approve sharing and importing income and tax information from the IRS to the FAFSA form, even if the attempt to obtain or use such data is ineffective.

If the parents filed separate 2022 IRS income tax returns, both must provide consent and approval to share and import income and tax information from the IRS on the FAFSA. In most cases, no further documentation is needed to verify 2022 income information

If 2022 income tax return information for the student and/or parent(s) was not available or could not be used, the student and/or parent should provide the institution with a 2022 IRS Tax Return Transcript(s) or a signed copy of the 2022 income tax return and applicable schedules (see additional instructions below).
